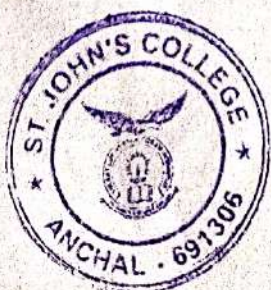

1. The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for cooperation and collaboration between the two institutions to promote academic and educational exchange.
2. Each institution agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
 - 2.1 Joint research projects in fields of mutual interests.
 - 2.2 Opportunities for faculty development as mutually agreed.
 - 2.3 Exchange of academic information and text materials.
 - 2.4 Training on Learning Management Systems and other digital technologies used in E-learning to faculty and students.
 - 2.5 Participating in seminars, symposiums and other types of academic discussions.
 - 2.6 Cooperating in career counseling and placement drives.
 - 2.7 Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed.
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the institutions. Each institution agrees to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws, regulations and policies of their respective institutions subject to mutual consultation and approval.
4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the institutions concerned.
5. Both institutions agree that prior written approval is required before using the other institution's name, logo or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.
6. This agreement imposes no financial obligations on either institution.
7. This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each institution.
8. This MoU is valid for a period of one year from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each institution. Each institution shall review the status of the MoU at least one month before the end of the period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to



continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both institutions.

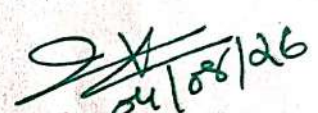
9. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the institutions upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than one month before the termination date.

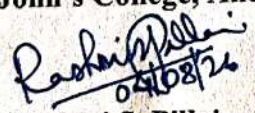

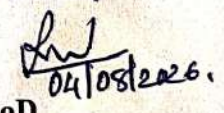

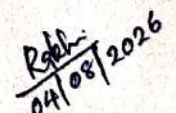
