Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this ____ day of _____, 2025,
between:

Karnataka, hereinafter referred to as "SABM", and

Don Bosco College -Kottiyam, Kollam, Kerala, hereinafter referred to as "DBC".

Purpose of the MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a formal academic and professional collaboration

Areas of Collaboration

The institutions agree to collaborate in the following areas:

1. Student Capacity-Building Initiatives

- SABM will conduct training programs and workshops for DBC students in
areas including but not limited to:

 - Data Visualization with Power BI
 - Negotiation Skills

 - Other contemporary business and professional skills as mutually agreed
2. **Faculty Development Programmes (FDP)**
- SABM will organize Faculty Development Programmes for the teaching faculty of DBC at the SABM campus in Mangalore.
3. **Student Engagement & Exposure**
- SABM agrees to host a **Management Fest** at its Mangalore campus where it will invite undergraduate students of DBC, enabling them to participate in competitive, leadership, and experiential learning events.
4. **Joint Research & Academic Initiatives**
- Both institutions may jointly explore collaborative research, knowledge-sharing workshops, conferences, and publications wherever feasible.

Responsibilities of the Parties

School of Business and Management, St Aloysius (Deemed to be University)

- Provide expert resource persons for workshops, training programs, and FDPs
- Host the management fest and coordinate student participation from DBC
- Provide access to academic resources and campus facilities as per program requirements
- **Don Bosco College -Kottiyam**
- Facilitate participation of students and faculty in the programs conducted by SABM
- Support coordination, logistics, and communication related to collaborative activities
- Encourage faculty and students to take part in research and academic collaborations

Duration

This MoU will be valid for a period of **three (3) years** from the date of signing and may be renewed through mutual consent.

Financial Arrangements

Financial implications, if any, for specific programs or activities will be mutually discussed and agreed upon on a case-by-case basis.



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Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality regarding information shared during collaborative activities, unless mutually approved for academic or research dissemination.

Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this MoU will be resolved amicably through mutual discussion and cooperation.

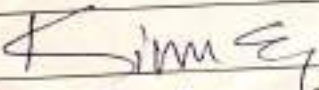
Termination
